*The studio waiting room will only be available for access by students and staff. Parents are encouraged to walk their children to the studio door for drop off and wait in their car.

*Wash and Sanitize hands before entering the dance room and after class.

*Staff will be sanitizing all equipment and hard surfaces in between each class.

*Students will be required to adhere to all social distancing. The dance area will be sectioned into spaces that are the required distance.

*If you are feeling unwell in anyway please do not attend class.

Zoom classes are still available to do at home. Please call and let the studio know you will be absent

RECITAL INFORMATION:

As our recital was originally set for June 18-20, we have rescheduled it for **August 27-29** at Franklin Community High School. I am sure there will be social distancing and guidelines given from the school. We will share those with you when we hear more from them. I will be posting the Dress Rehearsal day and times for each class as well as which day and time your Recital will be. Everyone will need to attend the **Dress Rehearsal which will be on the 27th of August.**

Recital fee due date will be given in June. We will continue to practice the recital routines to prepare for the show. More costumes have arrived and we will hand those out to you when we see you. If sizing adjustments need to be made we will try and get those taken care of from the companies they came from the best we can.

Our season will end at the conclusion of our Recital on Saturday, August 29, 2020.

Dress Rehearsal and Recital orders, days and times will be posted mid-June.

Due dates for orders for Recital t-shirts, DVDs, programs and flowers will be posted mid-June.

Studio Closed July 4-12

LRDA will be closed July 4th- July 12th.
Classes will resume on Monday, July 13, 2020.
Payments will remain the same for July and August in order to prepare for Recital.

Text message reminders

Prevention Steps in the Studio:

We have had the entire studio disinfected professionally by Funkhouser Restoration. They spent two hours spraying all surfaces with CLO2 with an electrostatic sprayer. They reached all high touch surfaces, props and mats. They then applied Zoono with an electrostatic sprayer to all surfaces, props and mats.

- Closed Lobby/Waiting Area: We will not have anyone except LRDA staff and students in the building. We ask that you drop dancers off at the front door and wait in your car. We will have the parking lot marked with the direction the traffic will flow around the building for drop off. ****Only Dance and Play parents who are needed for class and Everybody Dance Now parents who are needed are allowed in the studio. Only one parent or guardian allowed. No siblings or friends.**
- Sanitizer/Temperature: We will have all dancers use professional grade sanitizer provided by Le Rose Dance Academy as they enter the studio. We will also take each dancers temperature to make sure no one is running a fever.
- Hand washing: We encourage frequent hand washing (for at least 20 seconds before rinsing).
- Stamps: We will not be placing (good job) stamps on the little ones hands at the conclusion of class.
- Discouraging close contact: We have adjusted certain aspects of our classes to ensure dancers are not in too close proximity. We will not be giving hugs or hi-fives and are asking dancers to skip those as well.
- Surface Cleaning: Before/After each class we will be wiping down frequently touched surfaces and equipment with professional grade cleaner
- Deep Cleaning: Each week we are deep cleaning the studio.

Drop Off and Pick Up: You will turn into the parking lot and take an immediate right to go around the building for drop off and pick up at the main entrance to the studio and for parking. Please follow the direction so we can insure dancer's safety when entering and exiting their cars and the studio.

How Can You Help: - Read and sign the Release Statement.

- Dancers temperatures should be taken before coming to class.
- Don't bring toys or extra stuff from home.
- Parents and sibling/friends remain outside the building at all times.
- Pick up your dancer at the appropriate time.
- Zoom recordings will be available for students who are not in attendance if they are not able to take a Zoom live class.
- Don't send your child to the studio sick or if a family member is sick. If dancer or family member who lives with the dancer, has been in contact with someone who is or may be infected with the virus, that dancer should stay home for two weeks and join us on Zoom classes.
- Don't break any formal quarantine/government restrictions.
- Encourage your child to cough and sneeze into their arm not in their hand.
- Alert us if your child does have COVID-19 and have been to the studio within the last 14 days so we can contact their peers.
- Wash dancewear and tights after each class, wipe off shoes and dance bags with a sanitizer or cleaning product.
- Mask: Our instructors will not be required to wear masks. It is very difficult to breathe while dancing with a face covering. We are also aware of health issues that can occur due to rebreathing CO2 instead of fresh air while dancing. Children are more likely to play with and move their masks as they become uncomfortable making them more susceptible to germs. We will support your decision on whether or not you want your child to dance in a mask.

If for any reason you are not comfortable or confident in these safety measures, please keep your child home and continue doing class via Zoom. We feel very fortunate that we can offer both options to meet everyone's needs. The following families should keep their dancers at home for class:

- Anyone uncomfortable with sending their child to the studio for any reason at this time.
- Anyone with a dancer or family member that feels ill.
- Anyone living with an immunocompromised family member.
- Anyone living or interacting with elderly people on a regular basis.

In the coming days and weeks, we will continue to monitor the situation and pass along any pertinent information we gather.
